Rin's line provided for context: I am not naive to what a war like this will do, will force us to do. But, when we can be better, when we can show ourselves, and our people the difference between mercy and cruelty even for those that don't deserve it don't we have too? Isn't that what your Maker teaches Leliana?

LELIANA

(a humorless laugh)

He asks a lot.

(long beat. Sigh)

You feel very strongly about this. Very well. I will find another way to deal with this man.

(To her Agent)

Apprehend Butler. But see that he lives.

Cassandra has come to Leliana to try to understand her feelings. She worries about starting a relationship with the Inquisitor in the middle of the war.

LELIANA (cont'd)

You are the Hero of Orlais. You know the weight she carries. Do you wish her to find her comfort, to be just a woman, in someone else's arms or your own?

Only read these lines if you would like to reprise your role as Leliana in Dragon Age: Her Story

The Herald was abducted by Roderick's men, who believed she was responsible for the explosion at the Chantry. Leliana's men rescues her, but not before the Herald is badly hurt. In this scene the Herald confides in Leliana that she is having terrible, traumatic nightmares because of her capture, and Leliana hugs her.

LELIANA (cont'd)

I watched you nearly give your life to close the breech. We thought we would be safe in Haven to start working and Roderick...

(anger mounting)

We failed you. I failed you. I will not make that mistake again.

Haven is being attacked. The Herald has told her advisors that she will face Corpehyus alone. Leliana isn't happy about that, and has given into her feelings.

She passionately kisses The Herald, but the woman stops her, claiming there are things about her Leliana needs to know. This version of Leliana loved the Hero of Ferelden and lost him to the Archdemon.

LELIANA (cont'd)
We all have secrets and not all of
them are pretty. I care only for the
woman you are now. I have seen her
and I want her. I have not... not for
a very long time.
