2 INT. SAMARA'S CAR

It's a loud jarring impact but everyone is okay. From their vantage point, Dee's not getting out on her side and Liara is on the hood of the car, punching at the windshield over and over. It's cracked, but it's not breaking.

DEYANNA
That's not how I want to be railed, 1
asshole!

SAMARA
Are you okay?! 2

DEYANNA
I'm okay, are you? 3

SAMARA
I'm okay. 4

DEYANNA
How long for reboot? 5

SAMARA
15 seconds. 6

DEYANNA
Get Hayden's team here soon as you 7
have signal again.

SAMARA
She's persistent. 8

DEYANNA
Little bit. Will that glass hold? 9

SAMARA
It should. Whole car is built like a 10
tank. We can't go anywhere yet but
they can't get in either. Were you
really dating her?

DEYANNA
Not dating no. 11

SAMARA
So you're not seeing anyone? 12

DEYANNA
I've been single since we broke up. 13

SAMARA
Me too. 14

DEYANNA (V.O.)
I'm aware we were in a bad situation, 15
but that didn't stop me from leaning
forward, cupping my hand around the
back of Sam's neck and kissing her.

INTERCUT - EXT. STREET

The muffled voices from outside the car interrupt the two
love birds.

LIARA
I got this! 16

WARLOCK
Move. 17

LIARA
I said I got this! 18

3 INT. SAMARA'S CAR

DEYANNA (V.O.)
I slowed my kiss, and opened my eyes. 19
Some Gandolf looking dude got out of
the SUV that t-boned us. With a wave
of his hand, he tossed Liara aside. I
would have laughed but I heard the
door to our car start rattling.

DEYANNA
He's trying to pull it open. 20

SAMARA
That's not good. 21

DEYANNA
I'll stall hi- 22

There is a loud thwunk as another Warlock lands on the roof.
The sound of the straining metal gets more intense.

SAMARA
I think there's another one. 23

DEYANNA	
(straining)	
Well that's hardly fair.	24
SAMARA	
System error. Fuck. They must have	25
put something on the car.	
DEYANNA	
Plan C?	26
SAMARA	
I'm thinking- wait.	27
DEYANNA (V.O.)	
Sam leaned over to me, taking off my	28
chain with my wedding ring.	
DEYANNA	
Babe?	29
SAMARA	
Your ring has an emergency teleport	30
built into it.	
DEYANNA	
Really? Different from the one in my	31
old watch? Huh. When did you do that?	
SAMARA	
I'll explain later.	32
DEYANNA	
Where's it go? SVTDC?	33
SAMARA	
No. The basement.	34
DEYANNA	
Huh.	35
DEYANNA (V.O.)	
Sam rang her finger over the stone	36
three times, whispered something I	
couldn't hear and in a band of pale	
pink light we disappeared.	

4 EXT. STREET

Shift perspectives to the bad guys. The car door is ripped open finally.

WARLOCK
They're gone. 37

LIARA
Fucking how? You know what, don't 38
talk. And if you ever do that to me
again I'll drain you dry.

WARLOCK
Just call him. 39

LIARA
(mocks)
Just call him. 40

But she pulls out her phone and dials.

LIARA (cont'd)
They got away. 41

ALLIANCE
(disappointed)
Your incompetence is impressive. We 42
know where they've gone.

LIARA
So give me the location. 43

ALLIANCE
No. You've already made too much of a 44
mess. You were instructed to find and
detain Samara. Quietly.

LIARA
Deyanna was the easiest way to 45
Samara.

ALLIANCE
(sighs)
I'm starting to see why you left 46
Nomoria.

LIARA
Fuck you. 47

ALLIANCE
Clean up the scene and wait for my 48
call. You only get one more chance.

LIARA
Don't threaten me. 49

ALLIANCE
 It's not a threat. You wouldn't be 50
 the first Vampire we've got in
 containment. Be useful or be used.

Click.

LIARA
 Fucking asshole. Let's move. 51

The scene fades out as the SUVs speed away and the sound of
 siren's approach.

ROLL INTRO &
 PRE ROLL ADS

5 INT. BASEMENT - TELEPORTATION ROOM

We're back at the house from E1. The teleportation room is
 built like a safe room. Just the essentials in here, and a
 DIY teleportation platform in the center.

That platform pulses and a pale pink light surrounds it
 before Dee and Sam materialize into the space.

SAMARA (V.O.)
 One of the reasons we didn't sell the 52
 house was because I'd built a private
 teleportation portal in the basement.
 Only legal because we worked for SVT
 Dimensional Control and only for
 emergencies. After what happened two
 years ago I- I *needed* to know Dee
 could get home safe.

SAMARA (V.O.) (cont'd)
 I looked at her as she materialized. 53
 I'd been her safe place too. And
 she'd been mine. She still was mine.

SAMARA (V.O.) (cont'd)
 (sighs)

DEYANNA
 You okay? 54

SAMARA
 Yeah. Let's update Hayden. 55

Samara takes out her cell phone.

SAMARA (cont'd)
 Call Hayden. 56

We hear the phone dial and ring. It's answered almost immediately.

HAYDEN
Where are you? You good? 57

DEYANNA
We're safe. 58

SAMARA
I'm sending you the recordings from the car. 59

HAYDEN
Should give us a head start at identifying them. Your lead tomorrow must be damn good if they're putting in all this effort to stop you. 60

SAMARA
It is. We'll radio back in when it's done. 61

HAYDEN
Sure you don't want backup? 62

SAMARA
I've got backup. I've got Dee. 63

HAYDEN
You guys are gross. 64

SAMARA
You have no idea. 65

Samara ends the call.

DEYANNA
He doesn't know the details for tomorrow? 66

SAMARA
No. 67

DEYANNA
Very SVT of you. 68

SAMARA
Need to know isn't just a motto. 69

DEYANNA
Facts. But we don't think - 70

SAMARA
That he's alliance? No. Just being 71
extra cautious and keeping the circle
small.

DEYANNA
You're so smart and that's really 72
fucking hot.

SAMARA
(laughs)
You hungry? 73

DEYANNA
Starving. 74

SAMARA
Voice Activate Samara McCoy. 75

We hear the beep, the locks click, and the wall slides to
one side.

6 INT. BASEMENT

As the two walk through, the wall slides back into place,
seamless and invisible. A motion activated light illuminates
the basement. There's nothing special here, except one
singular memory that draws Sam inward.

SAMARA (V.O.)
At my voice command, the wall that 76
hid the teleportation room slid to
one side. The basement itself was
normal - sort of. But I paused,
looking at the work bench. At the
spot on the floor that was cleaned of
blood the night I'd gotten justice.
And the night I lost Dee.

DEYANNA
You okay? 77

SAMARA
Yeah. Memories. 78

DEYANNA
Yeah. I get it. 79

SAMARA
I could have handled that better. 80

DEYANNA
You handled him fine, if that's what we're talking about. 81

SAMARA
No. I mean... that night. The night we- we broke up. I could have handled that better. 82

DEYANNA
(beat)
I could have too. And all the days before it. And after it. 83

SAMARA
(beat)
C'mon. Fridge is full. 84

They exit the basement, heavy with memories, and walk upstairs into the kitchen.

7 INT. KITCHEN

The kitchen is devoid of all the things that once made it lived in. Now it's strictly functional, only the bare necessities on mostly empty counter tops.

There is evidence that Samara has been here though - a laptop on a table, and file folders next to it.

DEYANNA
You've been working here? 85

SAMARA
Yeah. Just for the last two weeks. After... us, I took a long sabbatical. 86

DEYANNA
I did too. 87

Dee opens up the fridge.

DEYANNA (cont'd)
I'm cooking. 88

SAMARA
I won't complain. Want a drink? 89

DEYANNA
Goddess yes. 90

91

SAMARA

I got you.

Dee starts pulling shit out of the fridge, and Sam goes over to the mini bar, making them both a drink. Dee starts cooking while they talk.

92

DEYANNA

So how did you manage to track down Todd's wife?

93

SAMARA

Wild ass coincidence.

94

DEYANNA

No shit?

95

SAMARA

I was at SVTDC two months ago, meeting the new recruits-

96

DEYANNA

I love them.

97

SAMARA

I do too.

98

DEYANNA

That new chick - Beth, have you had her muffins?

99

SAMARA

I tried one. It was okay.

100

DEYANNA

What? They're so good. Get the blueberry next time. Trust me.

101

SAMARA

Hmm. Maybe. Okay so new recruits. One of them, Paul was back from a recon mission. Nothing related to The Alliance at all. He tells me some woman stopped him in the street, asked for me, and gave him a phone number. Then she dipped.

102

DEYANNA

Shady as hell. Why not go with him? Paul is the nicest guy.

103

SAMARA

That's what I said.

DEYANNA
Wait. Maybe Anias was with him. 104
She's.... something.

SAMARA
Yeah she is. But no, Paul says he was 105
alone. I call the number. No answer.

DEYANNA
Oh that's super shady. 106

SAMARA
Super shady. So I go on the hunt. It 107
takes me another two weeks and
finally I find her. I straight up
cornered her coming out of the
Galactic Airport.

DEYANNA
That was brave of you. 108

SAMARA
I'd had enough of her shit to be 109
honest. Make me track her ass down
after asking for me.

DEYANNA
Fair. Here you go. 110

SAMARA
Thank you. Ugh. Smells so good. 111

DEYANNA
I'm a 5 star Michelin. 112

SAMARA
You know that's not a thing right? 113

DEYANNA
Lies. What happened next? 114

Sam is digging into the food, talking in between bites as
Deyanna sits down next to her.

SAMARA
She looks spooked. Extremely spooked. 115
She tells me she's Todd wife's,
that's she got information, and begs
me not to make her talk at the
Airport. Says she'll meet me.

DEYANNA
Huh.

(MORE)

DEYANNA (cont'd)

(thinking)

You know, it took me so long to track 116
Todd down. And all that surveillance
we did on that motherfucker before
the raid... I saw him with plenty of
women, and men, but I had no idea he
was married.

SAMARA

Right? I reviewed all that footage. 117
You don't see her with him, not once.

DEYANNA

You believe her? 118

SAMARA

I'm not sure. But if she does have 119
information it's worth checking out.

DEYANNA

Do we even think she's going to show 120
tomorrow night?

SAMARA

She might not. But it's clear The 121
Alliance thinks she is if they're
trying to stop me this bad.

DEYANNA

How the fuck do they even know? She 122
had to tell them right?

SAMARA

Maybe? But if she did, why not wait 123
and attack us at the meetup. Why do
all this?

DEYANNA

Good point. 124

(beat)

Where's the meetup at? 125

SAMARA

Public place. Open that second 126
folder.

Deyanna pushes one folder aside, and picks up the one Sam
mentioned. Opening it up there are surveillance pictures of
rooftop outdoor cafe.

DEYANNA

Photographs. Going old school. 127

SAMARA
With how spooked she was being... I 128
don't know. Something told me to just
keep everything close to vest.

DEYANNA
A woman's instincts are never wrong. 129
(studying the
pictures)
Rooftop cafe. That's good. Less 130
chance we'll get sniped. Not the most
secure location in the world, but I
can work with it.

SAMARA
You're the best. You'll keep us safe. 131

SAMARA (V.O.)
Dee's easy going expression left her 132
face. Fast. Too fast. She stopped
looking at the pictures in the folder
and stared at her near empty plate. I
worried I shouldn't have said that,
was it too soon? But... I believed
it. She'd already saved my life
tonight.

SAMARA
Dee- 133

DEYANNA
I'm okay. Thanks for the drink. You 134
still make a mean mojito.

SAMARA
Of course. 135

DEYANNA
I'll go through all this in detail. 136
I'll be ready for tomorrow, whatever
comes.

SAMARA
I know you will. 137

DEYANNA
Why did you ask for me? Me 138
specifically? I talk a lot of shit
but there are other Agents-

SAMARA
They're not as good as you. 139

DEYANNA
(beat)
I... I don't know if I deserve that. 140

SAMARA
You do. 141

DEYANNA
(beat)
But that's not the reason. 142

SAMARA
It's not, not the reason either. I 143
needed the best on this. We've been
chasing our tails when it comes to
getting a solid location for an
Alliance cell. They're taking people
and we can't find them. It has to
stop.

DEYANNA
Agreed. 144

SAMARA
(beat)
I wanted to see you, too. I- I wanted 145
to know what it would feel like...
what I would feel like... being back
in your orbit.

DEYANNA
What's it feel like? 146

SAMARA
What's it feel like for you? 147

DEYANNA
Familiar. Not different but... not 148
the same either.

SAMARA
Is that- 149

DEYANNA
-A good thing? 150

SAMARA
Yeah. 151

DEYANNA
You said earlier I wasn't always 152
crazy about you. That's not true. I
was Sam. I still am.

SAMARA

(beat)

Being near you again makes me feel 153
good. Makes me feel like- like me
again.

DEYANNA

Sam I- 154

SAMARA

Don't say it. 155

DEYANNA

Okay. 156

(beat)

Did you mean it? When you said you 157
loved me?

SAMARA

(beat)

Yes. 158

DEYANNA

(beat)

What you said before? I heard you. I 159
really don't want to hurt you. Or me.

SAMARA

I know. 160

(beat)

I'll clean up. 161

DEYANNA

Thanks. 162

SAMARA

Some of your clothes are still 163
upstairs if you want to change.

DEYANNA

You mean the hoodies you stole. 164

SAMARA

Was it really stealing though? 165

DEYANNA

(laughs)

Deyanna scoots back her chair, walking out of the kitchen
and up the staircase.

SAMARA (V.O.)

Just the small sounds of her leaving 166
one room and going into another
were... achingly familiar. I... I
probably should have stayed put. Done
the dishes.

SAMARA (V.O.) (cont'd)

But I'd also made her a promise 167
before we left the club...

We hear Samara's chair scoot back. The sounds of her
footsteps moving through the house and up the stairs after
Dee.

8 INT. BEDROOM

SAMARA (V.O.)

I found her in our bedroom - what use 168
to be our bedroom. She was sitting on
the bed, looking at nothing, at
everything. Memories. I understood.
And it did stupid things to me to see
her sitting there again. She smiled
when she saw me. Fuck. I smiled back,
crossing the threshold. I still had
her ring. I took it out of my pocket
and put it back around her neck. It
belonged on her finger. I was...
startled to realize how much I wanted
it back on her finger. Dee lifted the
ring, kissed it and smiled at me. She
had such a soft charming smile. It
made me melt. Even now. I took both
her hands, pulling her closer,
backing up into the bathroom.

9 INT. MAIN BATHROOM

We hear the sound of the hot water turning on. The rustle of
cloth as the two women undress.

SAMARA (V.O.)

I pushed her back against the shower 169
wall. It thrilled me when she let me
do that, because I honestly couldn't
have moved her if she didn't want me
too. Dee was all lean, sexy, muscle
and golden brown skin. She looked too
damn hot in most things, impossibly
hot under the spray of the dual
shower heads.

SAMARA (V.O.) (cont'd)
 I did want to kiss her everywhere, 170
 but she framed my face and kissed my
 lips and made it so hard, too hard to
 go slow. My hand was between her
 legs, and I felt hers on me. She
 touched me the way I touched her,
 slid her fingers inside me when I did
 the same, and I couldn't stand how
 good it felt, feeling her fucking me
 while I was fucking her. I wanted her
 to come with me, it was my favorite
 thing in the world, and I pressed my
 lips against her ear, letting her
 hear me.

SAMARA (V.O.) (cont'd)
 She didn't last too long after that. 171
 Neither did I. I was panting into her
 shoulder, cupping her tightly,
 feeling her writhe against my hand,
 while I pulsed against her fingers
 still inside me.

DEYANNA
 I love coming with you. 172

SAMARA
 Me too. Me too. 173

DEYANNA
 Come again for me, Sam. 174

SAMARA
 Right now? 175

DEYANNA
 In a moment. 176

SAMARA (V.O.)
 Her fingers slipped out of me, and I 177
 was moved. If you've never had a
 woman you loved on her knees in front
 of you, putting one of your legs over
 her shoulder, you're missing out. I
 almost did come again, immediately
 when I felt her lips. Her tongue slid
 through me, soft and slow. She teased
 the tip of her tongue around my
 entrance, and I couldn't breathe.

(MORE)

SAMARA (V.O.) (cont'd)
 She pushed her tongue where her fingers had been, groaning at the taste of me, and I tangled my fingers in her hair, letting her and the wall support me more than my leg. It felt so fucking good I wanted to come, but I didn't want her to stop, and I was stuck in that incredible in between until she made me come, sucking on my clit like that.

DEYANNA
 You taste so fucking good. 178

SAMARA
 Brat. You're such a brat. 179

DEYANNA
 (laughs)

SAMARA (V.O.)
 She turned off the shower and picked me up, carrying me into the bedroom. I kissed her shoulder, nuzzled my face into her neck. But when my back hit the mattress, I pushed at her shoulders and we rolled, until I was on top. 180

SAMARA
 Don't move. 181

DEYANNA
 Yes ma'am. 182

SAMARA (V.O.)
 Finally I had the control to do what I wanted. I put my mouth everywhere. I kissed every inch of her, and if I lingered on her breasts, with my teeth and tongue teasing her nipples and soft skin, I can't be blamed because she had perfect fucking breasts. 183

SAMARA
 I want inside of you. 184

DEYANNA
 Yes. 185

SAMARA
 Tell me. 186

DEYANNA	
Please.	187
SAMARA	
Tell me.	188
DEYANNA	
Inside me. Please.	189
SAMARA (V.O.)	
There were things I'd left here.	190
Things in this house neither of us had claimed, and I was thankful for it now. I reached into the night stand and pulled out the double ended strap. I rose to my knees, and Dee licked her lips as I put one end inside of me. I took hold of the strap, rubbing the head against her clit, making her whimper and I gasped. Pantheon bless the year 3046 because the sex toys were really peak. I could feel it, every time I teased her. She was so wet, I didn't need to use lube. I slid inside her slow, and I could feel that too and it was so damn ethereal being inside a woman you loved. DEYANNA
Yes... yes... for you. 198

SAMARA (V.O.)
I drew it out, fucking her slow and 199
deep, like I had all the time in the
world. Chasing the pleasure, basking
in it, was as satisfying as having an
O. We kissed, slow. Loving. Soft lips
and tender smiles. Her hands traced
my flushed skin with a reverence that
made my heart ache and my pleasure
spike. I did finally let her come,
with my fingers laced with hers, with
her arms above her head, her eyes
locked to mine. And ooooh, I wanted
to come with her but I was
insatiable. You'll have to excuse us,
there's lost time to make up for. So
get out.

The epic love making music fades into the sight of night
and -

10 INT. ALLEYWAY

Liara has some poor dude jacked up against a wall in an
alleyway down town.

LIARA
Show me your neck. That's a good boy. 200

Her phone rings. She keeps the guy pinned where he is, and
answers the phone.

LIARA (cont'd)
(annoyed sound)
What? 201

ALLIANCE
Ready to redeem yourself? 202

LIARA
Just give me the details. 203

ALLIANCE
I'm sending the location to your 204
phone. Do. Not. Enter. They are
meeting someone tomorrow.
(MORE)

ALLIANCE (cont'd)
Follow them when they leave. Do not
be seen. Once you are there, send the
location to me. Do you understand?

LIARA
Fine. Whatever. 205

ALLIANCE
Don't fuck this up, Liara. 206

LIARA
It's handled. 207

ALLIANCE
Good girl. Enjoy your snack. 208

Click.

LIARA
Is everyone on earth this annoying? 209
Ugh. You better taste good.

We hear the sounds of this poor man being drained dry.

PASSAGE OF TIME

It might not work, but let's do a fast forward of sound. The
sound of day, passing all the way through into night again.

11 EXT. HOUSE

Liara is sitting in a tree, a few houses down from Sam and
Dee's house. She's bored as hell.

LIARA
By the moon goddess, you've been 210
fucking all day, are we leaving
anytime soon?

(beat. Starts talking
to herself)
So what have you been doing since 211
leaving your perfect home planet? Oh,
nothing much. Except my ship slipped
through a wormhole and came to this
shitty place called Earth.

(beat)
There they are. Fuuuuck. Finally. 212
Hurry up. Get in the car. Let's go
already.

We hear the sound of Sam and Dee's car speeding away. Liara
starts dialing.

LIARA (cont'd)
 Get your team ready, I'm following them now. 213

Transition with the sound of speeding cars and an epic beat.

[INSERT MID
 ROLL AD]

12 EXT. ROOFTOP CAFE

The rooftop cafe is on the top of floor of a swanky building and decently busy for a Saturday night. Sam and Dee walk across the carpeted floors to the cafe's entrance.

DEYANNA
 Got your piece in? 214

SAMARA
 Do now. Mic check. 215

DEYANNA
 I hear you. Stay safe, Sam. 216

SAMARA
 I will. And, I have you. 217

DEYANNA (V.O.)
 She kissed my cheek and went inside. 218
 That trust she had in me, after
 everything. Okay. Okay. Keep it
 together Dee. Focus. I didn't like
 her being out of my sight, not even
 for the few seconds I needed to wait
 for her to go inside. I counted to
 fifteen, a fucking lifetime before I
 opened the door. It was a seat
 yourself type of establishment so I
 took up a spot at the bar. I had a
 clear view of the restaurant, and
 Sam.

We hear Sam's voice over Dee's earpiece.

SAMARA
 Nothing so far. 219

DEYANNA
 Nothing on my end either. Maybe she 220
 won't show.

SAMARA
Will you come back home with me if she doesn't? 221

DEYANNA
Do you want me too? 222

SAMARA
We could work on this together. 223

DEYANNA
You know I'm in. 224

SAMARA
You were in me pretty good earlier. 225

DEYANNA
(laughing)
Only pretty good? 226

SAMARA
Okay better than - clocked her. 227

DEYANNA
I see her. 228

DEYANNA (V.O.)
Samara was right - the woman looked spooked. Her braids were haphazardly piled on her head with a clip, she was wearing a wrinkled pants suit, clutching a large purse, her eyes darting everywhere. She walked hurriedly to Sam, sat down and immediately starting rummaging through her bag. 229

SAMARA
Nice to meet you again. 230

NOEL
I'm going to give this to you, and then you have to help me disappear. 231

SAMARA
Okay. What are you giving me? 232

DEYANNA
I shifted on my bar stool, pointing my phone towards the woman and pressed a button, doing a remote scan of her bag. I relaxed a little when it came back clean - no weapons. 233

NOEL	
Names.	234
SAMARA	
Alliance names?	235
NOEL	
SHHHH! Don't fucking say that out loud.	236
SAMARA	
All right, all right. I'm sorry.	237
NOEL	
Yes their names. Todd kept track.	238
SAMARA	
How did Todd know?	239
NOEL	
Because he was paranoid. He didn't trust anyone. And you shouldn't either.	240
SAMARA	
I don't.	241
NOEL	
I'm serious! You think you're safe because your SVTDC. You're not. You're stupid to think that. The worlds a mess now. Nobody is safe.	242
SAMARA	
People who work at SVTDC are on this list?	243
NOEL	
Yes. Todd said so. Higher ups though. Here take it.	244
SAMARA	
Did you look at this list?	245
NOEL	
No. It's not my business.	246
SAMARA	
(beat)	
Do you know who Todd was? What he was? Do you know what he took from me?	247

NOEL
Why do you think I came to you? 248

SAMARA
That doesn't answer my question. 249

NOEL
(beat)
I thought Todd was a pacifist who 250
liked playing dress up. I mean that's
what the Earth Military Coalition was
before all the bullshit right? Nobody
was at war. SVTDC did all the planet
and Dimension hopping. The EMC was
decoration really. But afterwards...
whatever a lot of people changed,
okay. Todd got spooked and I found
out he wasn't a pacifist he was
actually a coward.

SAMARA
He was a murder too. 251

NOEL
I know that. What do you want from 252
me? I didn't know he was going to
kill your sister. Getting you this
list is the only thing I can do.

SAMARA
But you knew he did it. How did you 253
know?

NOEL
Because he told me everything. 254
Because the night he did it he came
home crying. Said he fucked up. He
made me... he made me watch it. The
footage. What happened on that
boat... You don't go after SVT Agents
and get away with it. Even if The
Alliance did have people inside, it
wasn't going to save him. I knew
that. And I knew his stupidity was

I'm thinking about it. 258

NOEL
You're thinking about what? 259

SAMARA
Shut up a moment. 260

NOEL
Rude. 261

SAMARA
(beat)
Fine. We'll take her in. London can 262
deal with h-

DEYANNA
In between making love with Samara - 263
I'd been thinking of all the ways
someone might try and get at us if
the meeting was made. I'd called
someone I implicitly trusted and
asked her to plant a few recon
devices around the perimeter of the
cafe for me. The devices only job was
to alert me if someone was climbing
up the side of the building. Like
they were now.

DEYANNA (cont'd)
We got company, Sam. Grab her and 264
move to the d-

DEYANNA (V.O.)
Before I could finish I saw Liara 265
open the front door of the
restaurant. Shit.

SAMARA
Dee? 266

DEYANNA
Plan B. Get her to the bar and take cover. 267

DEYANNA (V.O.)
I pulled my side arm and fired into the air. I felt bad scaring all these poor people but I needed the chaos and it would alert emergency services. I jerked my gaze to Liara and sent her flying back through the door she'd come through. I bet she was tired of being tossed around. Welcome to Earth, asshole. DEYANNA (V.O.)

Options? Wait would my ring work again? 279

SAMARA

They're programmed for two, not three. 280

DEYANNA

So take Noel, and go. 281

No. It's a complete sentence. You take Noel, and go.	284
DEYANNA	
Absolutely not.	285
SAMARA	
Dammit Dee-	286
DEYANNA	
I said, what I said, Samara.	287
SAMARA	
Fine. Listen to me. Hey. I need you to breathe and pay attention. When you get to the basement-	288
NOEL	
(panicking)	
They're going to kill us. I don't want to die. I don't want to go to one of those facilities-	289
DEYANNA	
Less panicking more listening.	290
SAMARA	
Hey hey. Focus. They're not going to catch you. I'm going to teleport you away. When you get to the location you won't be able to get out of the room. You're not trapped. Your phone will work. You call this number, and this number only. You do not call anyone else. You tell London you're at the McCoy Estate. She'll know how to get you out.	291
DEYANNA	
And I want my ring back, so don't loose it.	292
DEYANNA (V.O.)	
Samara rubbed the ring, whispering something again and Noel disappeared.	293

SAMARA	
Plan D?	294
DEYANNA	
Okay just us two - I've got a semi terrible idea.	295
SAMARA	
I love your ideas.	296
DEYANNA	
Maybe not this one. We're gonna jump.	297
SAMARA	
Say more words.	298
DEYANNA	
We're gonna jump and right before we hit the ground I'm going to use my ability and stop us from dying.	299
SAMARA	
That's going to hurt.	300
DEYANNA	
What's a headache when I'll have you to wake up too.	301
SAMARA	
Sure you just don't want to kill them all?	302
DEYANNA	
Liara makes this fight harder. I'm pretty sure we could take them, but I can't fight her and them.	303
SAMARA	
Fair. Stupid Vampire. Okay. Let's jump.	304
DEYANNA (V.O.)	
Right as I said that, I heard my dual barricades get destroyed. I grabbed Sam's hand, and we booked it. Vaulting over the bar, right to the edge of the railing and jumped.	305
DEYANNA	
Get on my back!	306
SAMARA	
You can do this with two of us?!	307

DEYANNA
Hell of a time to want confirmation 308
babe!

SAMARA
I'm not worried about me, I'm worried 309
about you!

DEYANNA
I got it! 310

DEYANNA (V.O.)
I was 90% sure I had it. We dropped 311
rapidly to the ground, my eyes
blurring with the wind, so I relied
less on them and more on my
connection with Earth. Benefits of
being a witch and all. I put my hands
out in front of me and when I felt us
getting close enough to the ground I
focused on slowing our descent. I was
more than likely making a whole lot
of grunting man noises, because it

HAYDEN

But it will work on Dee. Wake her up, 322
then fetch the Warlock.

LIARA

About fuckin time. 323

Liara slaps the shit out of Dee.

SAMARA

I will fucking kill you if you touch 324
her again!

HAYDEN

Calm down, Sam. She can take a little 325
slap.

SAMARA

Not the fucking point. 326

DEYANNA

Owww. Biiitch. 327

LIARA
You deserve more than that for 328
tossing me out a fucking window.

DEYANNA
You tried to kill me first so. 329

LIARA
Whatever. 330

Liara walks off angry and impatient to find one of the Warlocks.

DEYANNA
Why is the light so bright... hang 331
on. Tied up. I'm tied up. Sam are you
tied up?

SAMARA
Yeah. We're in an Alliance Warehouse. 332

DEYANNA
That's annoying. Are you okay? 333

SAMARA
I'm okay. Are you okay? 334

DEYANNA
Bitchin headache. Hayden why are we 335
in - and you're with - Oh. Oh my
fucking god. You rat bastard.

SAMARA
That's what I said! 336

HAYDEN
Sorry, ladies. 337

DEYANNA
Seriously? You're Alliance? Fuck! Not 338
all men-

SAMARA
But somehow all fucking men! 339

DEYANNA
Right? It's like being back in the 340
2000s.

HAYDEN
This shit right here is why The 341
Alliance exists-

SAMARA
(interrupts)
Wild. I thought The Alliance existed 342
because you're a bunch of power
hungry fuckwads who think kidnapping
supernatural beings is okay.

DEYANNA
Was he going to give a speech? I 343
swear to Lilith, if you give a
villain speech I will off myself.

SAMARA
Absolutely not babe. 344

DEYANNA
Sam, I can't take a villain 345
monologue. This can't be our life.

SAMARA
I miss our life together. 346

DEYANNA
Me too. 347

SAMARA
I shouldn't have let you move out. 348

DEYANNA
I shouldn't have moved out. 349

SAMARA
It's just, you were gone so much 350
before. And I stopped going to
therapy-

DEYANNA
Babe! Why didn't you tell me? 351

SAMARA
I don't know! I stopped going because 352
loosing her didn't stop hurting and
it didn't feel like it was helping. I
wanted to feel better. I wanted to
feel like me again.

DEYANNA
I'm sorry. I'm so sorry about your 353
sister, Sam. And I'm sorry I closed
up after. I- she was on my team and
we lost her. That's why I was gone so
much. I had to find who killed her. I
had to find Todd. But I should have
been there for you.

SAMARA
No. Stop. This isn't all on you. I 354
never blamed you. Never. Didn't you
know that?

DEYANNA
I blamed me. 355

SAMARA
I blamed *him*. And it hurt less after 356
he was dead. So thank you, Dee. Thank
you for finding him.

DEYANNA
(suddenly crying)
I felt better after we killed him 357
too. It was so healing.

SAMARA
It really was. 358

DEYANNA
We're getting back together right? 359

SAMARA
Yeah we are- 360

A gunshot rings out, hitting Samara in the head.

DEYANNA
What the fuck!?! 361

HAYDEN
At least I let you get closure. 362

DEYANNA
You just shot my wife in the head, 363
you fucking asshole!

HAYDEN
News flash, Dee! She's not your wife 364
anymore. And now she's really not,
because she's dead.

DEYANNA
How did I not know you were a piece 365
of shit all along.

HAYDEN
Because you're not as smart as you 366
think you are.

DEYANNA
The fuck I'm not. 367

HAYDEN

Oh, all that pussy power didn't help 368
you in the long run did it? Sam's
sister dead. Sam's dead. And guess
what princess? Your next.

DEYANNA

You just fucking loooove hearing 369
yourself talk.

HAYDEN

Actually yeah. I do. Sit tight. We'll 370
read your mind, I'll kill you, and
maybe you two can reincarnate
together. So romantic.

SAMARA

(a roar of fury)

HAYDEN

Wh- no. NO. How?! 371

DEYANNA (V.O.)

You remember how I said Sam wasn't 372
from Earth? Well, fun fact Sam's race
had the ability to shape-shift and
some of them, chose Dragons. The way
Sam explained it to me, this
particular ability only activated
under extreme duress, as a defense
mechanism. Not everyone on their
planet had it. We'd hoped Sam's
sister had the same ability but...
no. Anyway, if you've never watched
your girl turn into a fucking dragon
you're really missing out. The
transformation was instant. She
wasn't dinosaur size, but she took up
half the room, and when she extended
her wings, she busted up all the
crates in the warehouse and even put
a hole in the wall.

DEYANNA (V.O.)
 I took off my jacket, wrapping it around since she was naked now and all.

HAYDEN
(pain filled groan)

DEYANNA
Oh, you're still alive? Persistent 382
little cockroach.

SAMARA
He won't be alive much longer. That 383
breathing sounds bad.

DEYANNA
Really bad. 384

HAYDEN
How... did... you... 385

DEYANNA
Oh! You didn't know Sam's race could 386
do that? Well, I mean it was bold of
you to assume your SVT Security
clearance was high enough to know
details that weren't important to
your job.

SAMARA
Stupid of him really. 387

DEYANNA
Really stupid. Like he doesn't know 388
who he works for.

SAMARA
Probably because he was just 389
pretending to work for SVT.

DEYANNA
Oh. Wait. Do they tell you everything 390
The Alliance? They can't be that
dumb.

SAMARA
Can you find out before he bleeds 391
out?

DEYANNA
I can try. Not like I have to worry 392
about doing brain damage.

HAYDEN
Don't... touch me. 393

DEYANNA
Shut up. 394

DEYANNA (V.O.)
 I put my fingers against Hayden's temple. Reading the mind of an unwilling subject wasn't like in the movies. You couldn't just do it. Most people had natural defenses, even if they didn't know it and pushing yourself into someone's mind was an invasion plain and simple. You could hurt them and yourself if you didn't know what you were doing. I did know what I was doing, and I didn't much care if I hurt Hayden. But when I started poking through his memories, looking for information on the Alliance I was not expecting what I found.

DEYANNA
 What the fuck... what the fuck.

SAMARA

SAMARA
 (laughs)
 We're not a movie, and this is 413
 definitely not the end.

DEYANNA
 Promise? 414

SAMARA
 Promise. I'm not losing you again,
 Dee. 415

DEYANNA
 You didn't lose me the first time. 416

SAMARA
 Well a year without you sucked and 417
 I'm not doing it again.

DEYANNA
 Deal. How's Quill? 418

SAMARA
 She's with my parents. They're on a 419
 luxury cruise around Venus.

DEYANNA
Ooooh. Bougie. Good for her. She 420
deserves it.

SAMARA
She really does. 421

DEYANNA
